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INDIAN ROAD CONTRACT AWARDED TO RAPID CITY BIDDER

Award of a contract for grading, draining and crushed-gravel surfacing of 13.4 miles of road on the Lower Brule Indian Reservation in Lyman County, S. Dak., to R. C. Van Houten and Sons, Rapid City, S. Dak., was announced today by the Department of the Interior.

Van Houten's bid of \$112,882.94 was the lowest of eight received. The others ranged from \$115,985.94 to \$168,140.82.

The project is part of a larger plan to provide all-weather transportation for a distance of about 43 miles across the reservation from the Subagency headquarters to the extreme northwest corner. Five miles of this road from the Subagency has already been improved to a standard that will meet the traffic needs.

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
