2012 President's Budget

- Starting point for FY 2012 budget is FY 2010 Enacted/2011 Continuing Resolution
- Detailed tables in greenbook do not display FY 2011 column because current year level is uncertain
- Extensive Tribal consultation was engaged through the Tribal/Interior Budget Council (TIBC)
- Includes strategic cuts at central office to fund Tribal priority increases
- Fixed Costs - Federal pay raise not included, but adjustment for tribal employees is included
