



## Sanostee's April Opening

Just over 15 months from its January 2011 ground-breaking ceremonies, the replacement school at Sanostee, N.M., opened in April 2012. The school's construction included the development of supporting infrastructure with electrical, gas, water and sewer. Now, 88 K-3 students have a new 24,306 square foot school. The project manager was Melvin Tsethlikai of Zuni Pueblo, who works for OFMC in the Navajo Regional Office.
