



OFMC, OJS Working on Employee Housing, Modular Offices

OFMC and the Office of Justice Services have created priority lists for both constructing new employee quarters and installing modular buildings to serve as police offices and substations. OFMC has already funded employee housing units and installed some modular offices to assist with the growth of OJS services at four reservations which are part of the High Priority Performance Goal, a Presidential Initiative to reduce crime on targeted reservations.

As funds become available, OFMC will be installing 34 modular buildings as requested by OJS:



Modular buildings were installed at Wind River Agency in Wyoming to assist with the OJS High Priority Performance Goal, a Presidential Initiative to reduce violent crime on target reservations.
