##### **Web-based Tribal Adaptation and Mitigation Forums**

*Rosebud Sioux Tribe of the Rosebud Indian Reservation*

Grant Award: \$149,574

*Project Description:* Design and present web based climate adaptation planning for tribes.

##### **Capacity Building Workshop: Monitoring of Toxic Phytoplankton Impacts on Subsistence Foods.**

*Sitka Tribe of Alaska*

Grant Award: \$47,900

*Project Description:* Provide training for tribal staff to monitor for toxic algal blooms of phytoplankton to enable tribes to protect the health of substance harvesters as climate change increases the recurrence of dangerous conditions.

##### **Workshop: Characterizing Tribal Cultural Landscapes and Values in the Context of Rising Sea Levels.**

*Yurok Tribe of the Yurok Reservation, California*

Grant Award: \$59,800

*Project Description:* Host an intertribal workshop using Cultural Landscape Approach to identify tools best practices and case studies for tribes to identify and communicate areas of significance that will be impacted by rising ocean waters as a result of climate change.

Grant Award: \$101,683

*Project Description:* Expand the climate change analysis in the Tribe's Integrated Resource Management Plan to encompass health, first foods, and detailed predictive modeling to improve resolution.

*Native American Protection Coalition*

Grant Award: \$73,360

*Project Description:* Provide climate assessment tools and training to 8 member tribes to serve as a foundation for tribal climate adaptation plans, and capacity gained in the pilot to support additional member and southwest Tribes in the same.

**Tribal Government Adaptation Plan and Vulnerability Assessment Template**

Grant Award: \$26,426

*Project Description:* Vulnerability Assessment and development of a strategic climate adaptation plan.

Grant Award: \$156,761

*Project Description:* Coordinate a partnership with N. Olympic Peninsula land managers for a collaborative climate impact assessment and follow up with the development of a tribal Adaptation Plan.

Grant Award: \$52,655

*Project Description:* Climate adaptation initiative to determine the current and projected impacts of climate change on the Kickapoo community and reservation and prioritize key areas for adaptation management, culminating in the development of a Kansas tribal adaptation plan.
