It seems current re-recognition process for tribes is too complex and time consuming. We support the Laws recommended to simplify and shorten the time for re-organization of terminated tribes. Terminated tribes have suffered too much injustice from United States government already. In compassion to past mistakes and horrors this is a simple step to righting a historic wrong.
